

## **ITTF ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE**

The Annual General Meeting (AGM), is the supreme governing body of the ITTF and consists of the assembled representatives of the 227 Member Associations ([ITTF Handbook 1.5.1.1](#)).

[The Board \(BoD\)](#), is a legislative authority of the ITTF dealing amongst other responsibilities with all ITTF regulations, except the Constitution and the Laws of Table Tennis ([ITTF Handbook 1.5.3.1](#)).

[The Executive Committee](#) (EC) is, as per the ITTF Constitution, the executive body of the ITTF, with the power, among other duties, to approve the internal Organisation rules, to appoint the CEO, to appoint the Chairs of the Committees, Commissioners, Working Groups and all Members of the Nominations Committee ([ITTF Handbook 1.5.4](#)).

The Continental Council includes the ITTF Executive Committee and the [Presidents of the Five Recognized Continental Federations](#) ([ITTF Handbook 1.3.1.1](#)) and its primary duty is the planning, control and supervision of the table tennis events in the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Professional Staff implements the day-to-day activities and operations of the ITTF, as per the [Strategic Plan](#) and the guidance of the Executive Committee and the CEO.

The different committees (Equipment, Media, Nominations, Para Table Tennis, Rules, Sport Science & Medical, Umpires and Referees, Veterans), the Commissioners (Gender, Junior, Technical), and the Athletes Commission, assist the ITTF with their expertise in different areas. See them [here](#).
